

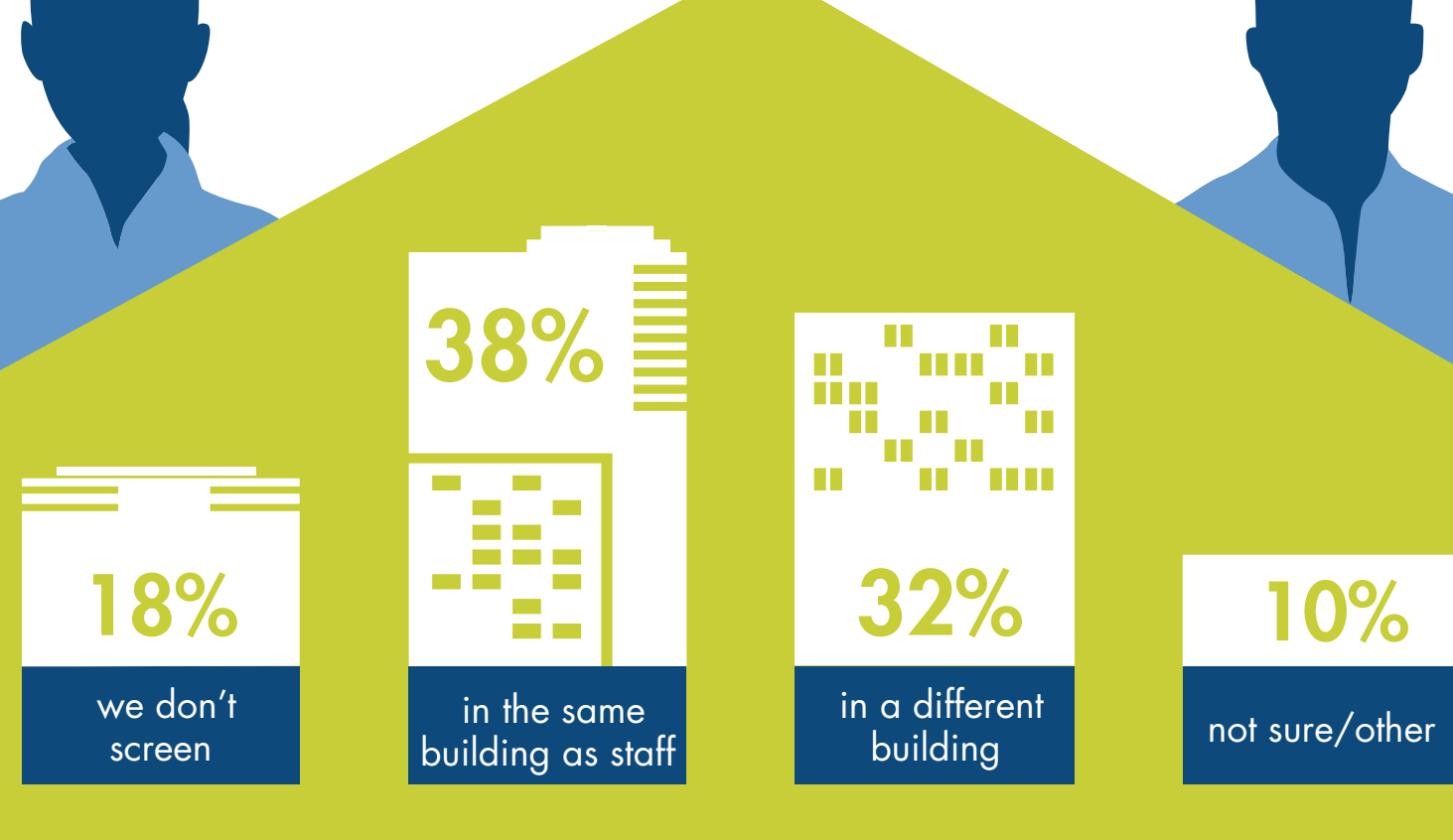
Mail threats/hoaxes received last year

40% of respondents received at least one threat.

25% of those threatened received more than five threats.



U.S. Postal Inspectors respond to suspicious mail incidents nearly every day. More than 5,000 in the last two years alone. (U.S. Postal Inspection Service Annual Report FY 2015)



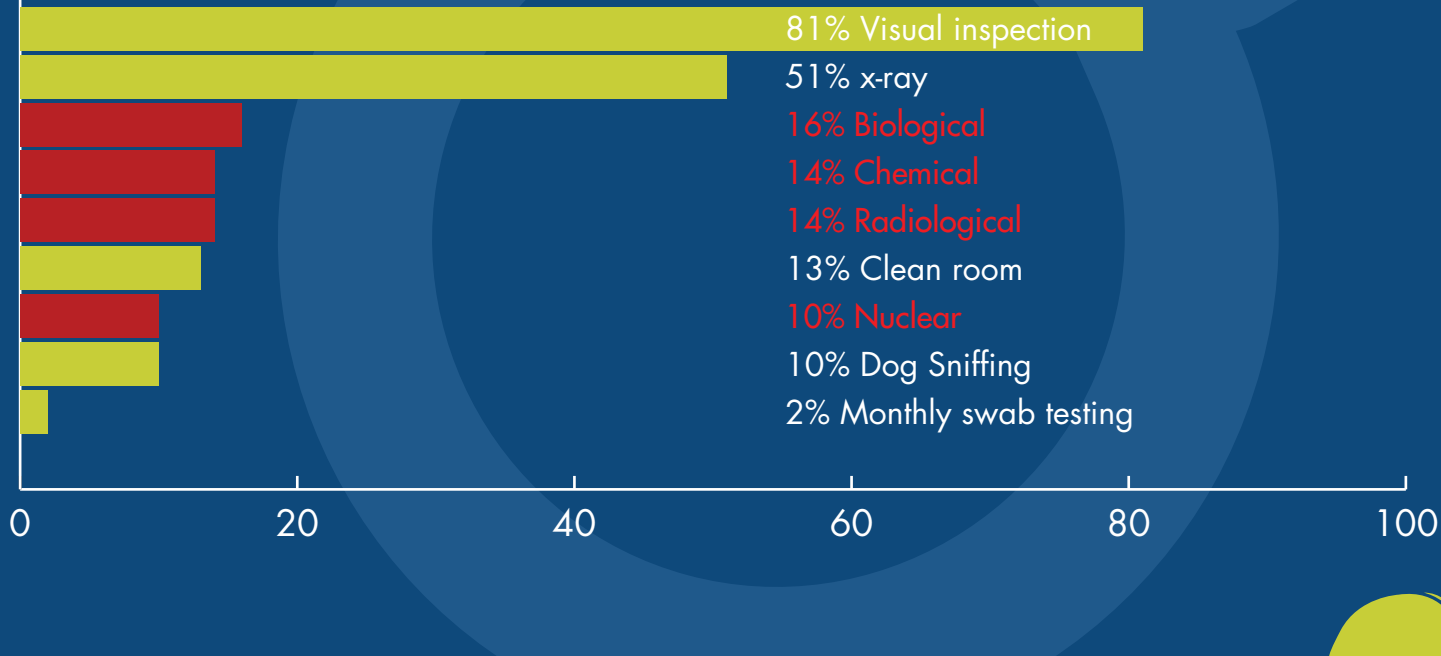
Where is your mail screened?

Best Practice: Screen mail in a different building or in a design-built contained environment to reduce employee health concerns and keep your business running.

What type of screening procedures do you use?



Caution! Visual and x-ray inspections DO NOT detect biological, chemical, radiological or nuclear threats.

76% are aware ISIS is working on Chemical and Biological Weapons.

37% feel less safe because of it.

19% ONLY 19% are confident that biological and chemical threats will be detected in their mail.

Compared to a year ago, 43% are more concerned about mail safety. But ONLY 22% have increased mail security at their organizations.



ONLY 60% have mail security training in their organizations.

Best Practices for Being Prepared

1. "Learn by doing" achieves a 75% retention rate. Practice threat simulations with your team.
2. Document a plan and review it with your team.
3. Post a flyer for the signs of suspicious mail. Download one for free at SoBranSafeMail.com
4. Get training annually for employees that handle mail, and within the first two weeks for new hires.
5. Post emergency numbers prominently as a constant reminder to be vigilant.
